Jill Pranger Earns Highest Professional Fundraising Credential from AFP

The Association of Fundraising Professionals, the largest community of professional fundraisers in the world, has awarded its highest professional certification, the Advanced Certified Fundraising Executive (ACFRE), to Jill A. Pranger of Webster.

Available only to senior-level fundraisers who have worked in the profession for 10 or more years, the ACFRE is a distinguished achievement earned by only 78 professionals since the inception of the program in 1992.

The ACFRE program is the most rigorous certification process available to professional fundraisers. The process includes a comprehensive application, detailing achievements in practice, education, publishing, teaching, and service to the profession; a written examination that measures a candidate's knowledge of fundraising as well as the philosophical, ethical, and social aspects of philanthropy; a portfolio representing the candidate's body of professional work; and an oral peer review in which the candidate must articulate a mastery of advanced-level knowledge in fundraising management, leadership, and ethics.

Of the ACFRE process, Ms. Pranger says, "In completing each stage, I realized just how much I had learned and accomplished as a fundraising professional. Compiling and analyzing my educational activities and fundraising practice, and developing a portfolio of written work was reinforcing to me professionally and personally. I encourage others to take the steps to achieve this advanced credential - you'll learn so much about yourself and your professional contributions. It is well worth it!"

The ACFRE Certification Board of AFP, chaired by S. Sanae Tokumura, ACFRE, APR, oversees the ACFRE candidate review process. Ms. Pranger will be honored for her achievement during AFP's 43rd International Conference



on Fundraising in Atlanta, in April.

Ms. Pranger has been a fundraising professional for more than two decades and nearly three years ago, she established an independent consulting firm, Pranger Consulting and Training, which helps not-for-profit organizations develop or enhance their fundraising programs. With a client base that extends throughout the northeast, Pranger Consulting and Training specializes in engaging staff and volunteers throughout the fundraising process and provides training designed to increase their comfort level while doing so. Prior to establishing her firm, Ms. Pranger was employed by organizations including the William E. Simon Graduate School of Business Administration, Seneca Park Zoo Society, Highland Hospital Foundation, Planned Parenthood, and National Technical Institute for the Deaf.

In addition to her business and professional activities, Ms. Pranger is active with the local not-for-profit sector, currently serving as President of the Junior League of Rochester and as a 30-year volunteer with the American Red Cross. Additionally, she and her husband, Charlie Miersch, enjoy golfing, biking, and skiing.
